We will be selling raffle tickets, and people will be encouraged to place their purchased raffle tickets in the box next to the cake they are voting for. The three winners (one in each age division) will be the three cakes with the most raffle tickets at the end of the event. The event will run from 10:00-2:00, with winners announced near 2:00. **New this year – all cakes will go HOME with their creators!!**
