## This year, our library...



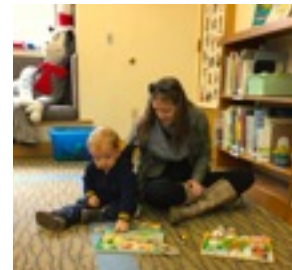
- Hosted a community Read with support from the Myrtle Dee Nash Memorial Fund of the Community Foundation of Tompkins County.
