Kids and teens enrolled in Summer Reading Program read 719 books! Adult Summer Reading Program participants read 1,350 books!

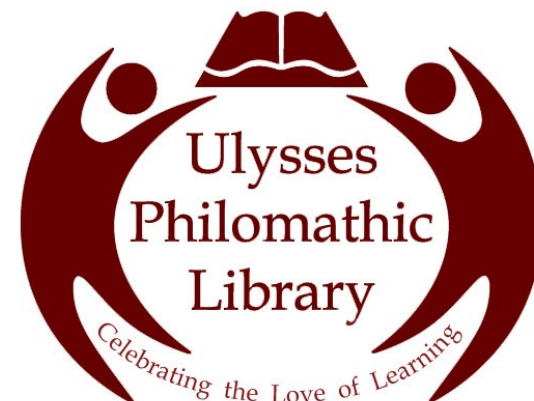
Our volunteers gave us 3,665 hours this year, thank you!
