Our first outside book sale! Tent rental generously funded by a Community Foundation of Tompkins County Resilient Communities grant.

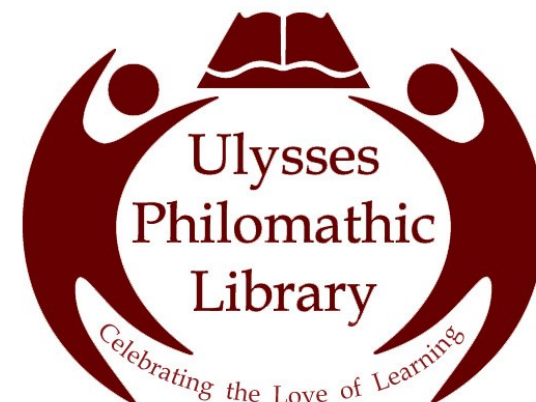


We had to quarantine a lot of books! These boxes were full of books that cleared quarantine over a weekend.
