

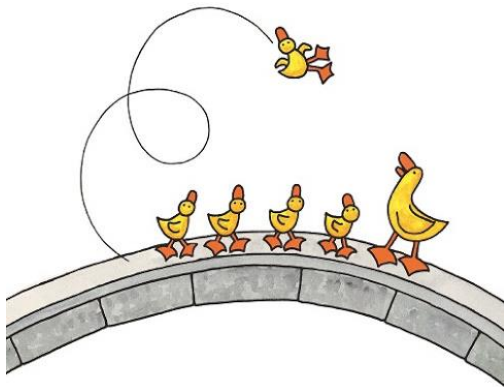

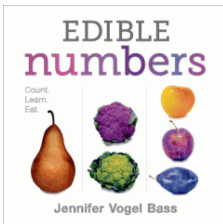

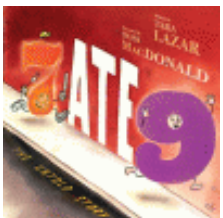
What is a day of counting with Barefoot Critters? Making pancakes, helping friends, exploring, swimming, playing pirates, learning about numbers!

Illustrations and simple, rhyming text reveal a day at school, from one backpack to seven stars on a chart and back down again.

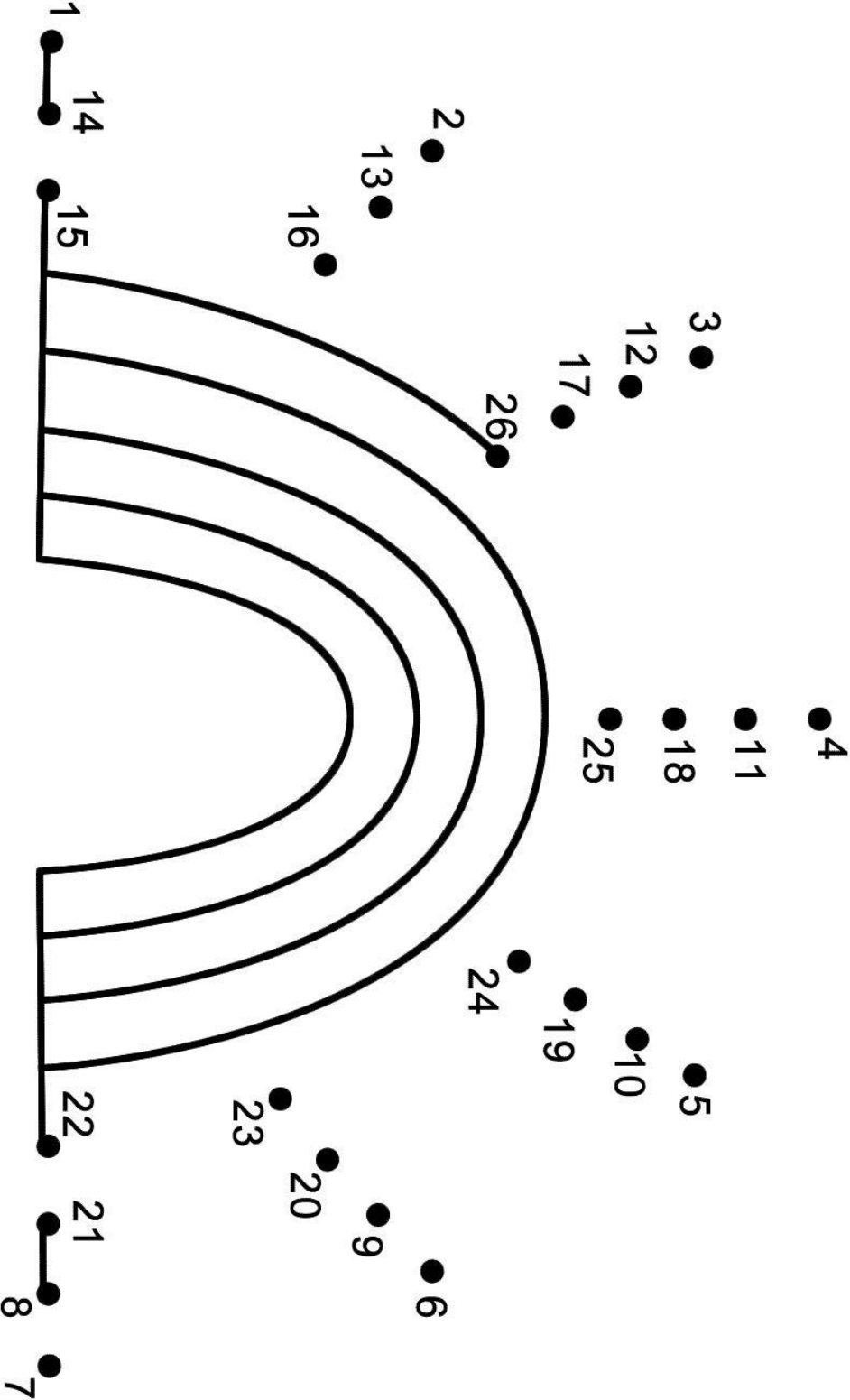
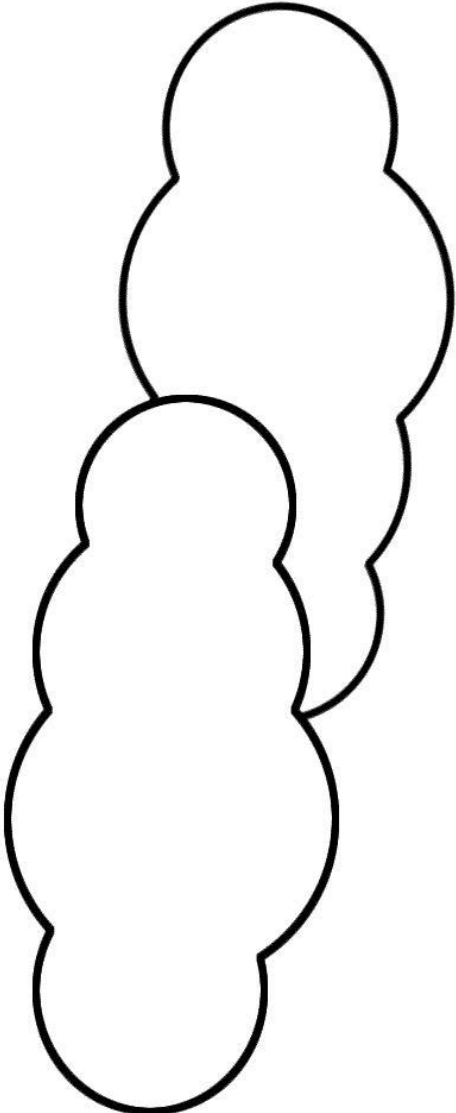
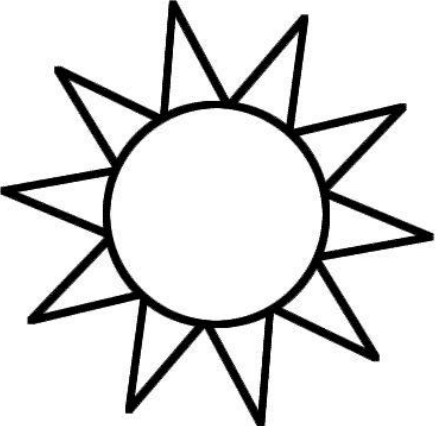

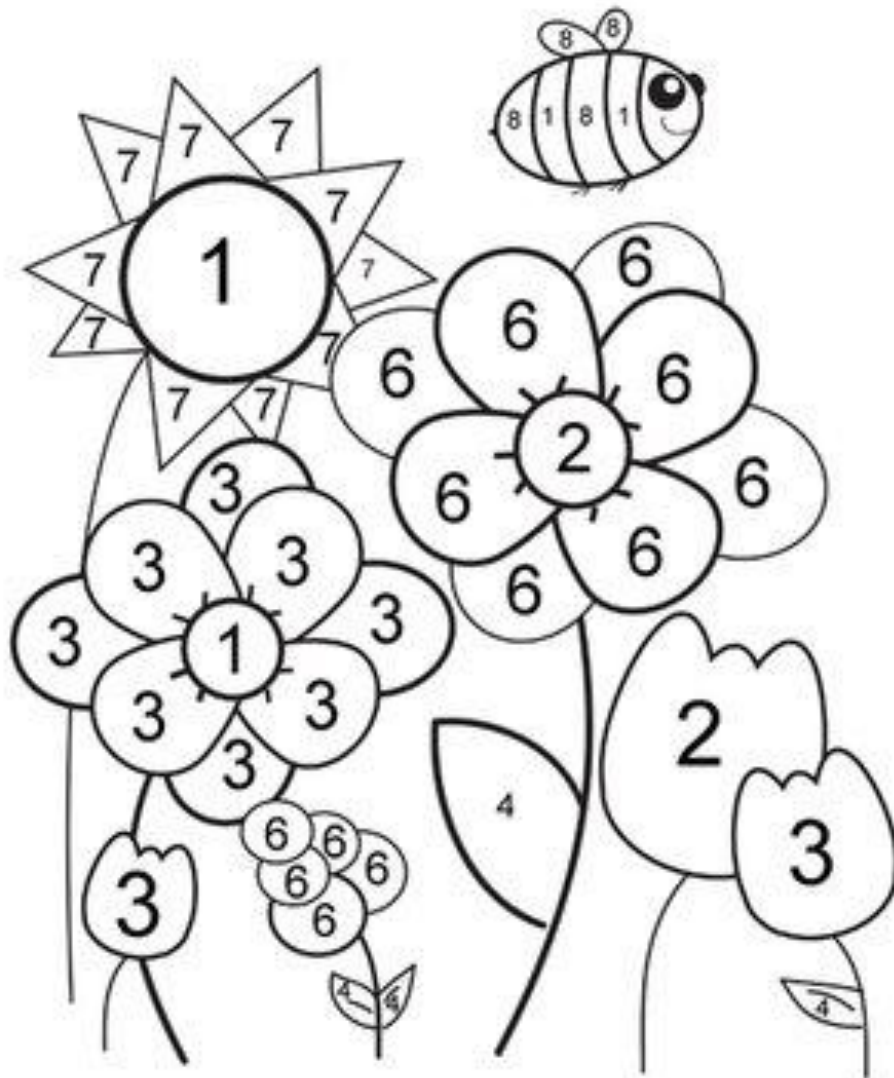
