COMPUTER AND INTERNET USE POLICY ULYSSES PHILOMATHIC LIBRARY

Users are expected to access the internet in a legal manner. Displaying or printing images of child sexual abuse, or those which are sexually explicit, obscene, or harmful to minors is prohibited according to the N.Y. Penal § 235.

Users who do not abide with the Library's Computer and Internet Use Policy and Rules of Behavior may be denied the privilege of using the library's computers and resources.

Parents or legal guardians of people younger than age 18 are responsible for their proper and safe use of the internet.

Library-Supplied Computers

- Any cardholder may use the library's computers, which are not equipped with filtering software.
- Computers are available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Users must sign in at the computer and sign out when they are finished.
- Users may use computers for up to 240 minutes per day, in 30-minute sessions. If no one is waiting to use the computer, users may continue to use them at 30-minute intervals until their daily minutes limit has been reached or someone else has requested to use the computer.
- The library reserves the right to limit the number of people at each computer.
- Printing charge is 20¢ per page. The first two pages per day per patron are free of charge.
- Patrons may not tamper with, alter, edit, damage or remove computer hardware, data and/or software.

Wireless and Ethernet Access

- These services are open to patrons of all ages.
- The library assumes no liability for damage, theft or loss of any kind to a user's equipment, software, data files or other personal property brought into and used in the building.
